The Practice:

- Based on the title and the specified objectives of the practice, the programs and activities are being organized with respect to empower the girls with respect to all the issues that the girls faces in their day to day life and even they have to face in their married life.
- A committee for this practice has been formed to conduct and organize programs and activities for confidence building of the girls, to provide them knowledge of women's related regulations through experts, to organize seminars and guest lecturers to enlighten them with their health related issues and remedial measures for it.
- The MoUs are signed with the institutions specially working for the empowerment of women and the activities and programs are being organized for the success of the practice.

Constraints and Limitations:

- Most of the girls in the institution are from rural background and attend the college from about 25 Kms. Such girls find it difficult to take benefit of the practice if they remain absent.
- To overcome the misconception among the rural girls is a great hurdle in participating them in the activities based on bold and daring acts.

- The girls are taking full interest in the guest lecturers organized for their confidence building.
- They give good response to the practical based activities related to their health issues.

- Time management in the institution for such programs become difficult during the examination schedule of the students as they have examination and preparation for it is in their minds.






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
