BETWEEN

AND

"NSS COLLEGE OF COMMERCE & ECONOMICS", having its college premises situated at Tardeo, Mumbai-34 (Maharashtra), represented by its Principal, Dr. Shamim Sayed hereinafter referred as "COLLEGE**" (which term shall wherever the context so requires, mean and include its successors and assigns) of the "SECOND PARTY"

AND

"MAHILA MAHAVIDYALAYA, NAGPUR" having its college premises situated at Nandanvan, Nagpur, represented by its Principal Dr. Vandana Bhagadikar hereinafter referred to as "COLLEGE**" (which term shall wherever the context so requires, mean and include its successors and assigns) of the "THIRD PARTY"

WHEREAS YASHODA GIRLS' ARTS AND COMMERCE COLLEGE, SNEHNAGAR, WARDHA ROAD, NAGPUR-MAHARASHTRA AND NSS COLLEGE OF COMMERCE & ECONOMICS, TARDEO, MUMBAI-34 MAHARASHTRA AND MAHILA MAHAVIDYALAYA, NAGPUR, MAHARASHTRA believing that the process of college education can be enriched and academic understanding strengthened, and recognizing the benefits to their respective institutions from the establishment of academic links and cooperation, conclude this agreement.

WHEREAS the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) as outlined in this document is not intended to be a legally binding document. Rather, it is meant to describe the nature and cooperative intentions of those institutions involved and to suggest guidelines for cooperation. Nothing, therefore, shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution nor may any constraints be imposed by either upon the other, and nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to create a partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship between the parties.

WHEREAS, ALL THE THREE PARTIES are hereby agreed to jointly organize training programme, Skill based programme, Seminars/Webinar, Online/Offline Faculty Exchange/Students Exchange Programs, workshops, faculty development programmes for teaching and non-teaching staff with sole purpose of Academic Development of the students as well as the teaching faculty and sharing the infrastructure and know-how.

AND WHEREAS the College has shown interest to have the college tie-up with Second Party and third party to enable the college to impart training or organize events and activities in collaboration like Skill based programme, Seminars/Webinar, Faculty Exchange, Students Exchange Programs, workshop, faculty development programmes for teaching and non-teaching staff.

AND WHEREAS ALL THE THREE COLLEGES have agreed to jointly organize Skill based programme, Seminars/Webinar, Faculty Exchange, Students Exchange Programs, workshop, faculty development programmes for teaching and non-teaching staff and sharing the infrastructure and know-how.

NOW THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES AND MUTUAL COVENANTS AND PROMISES MADE HEREINAFTER THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS –

1. The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this MOU shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties in a separate agreement, prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such implementation agreements will form appendices to this memorandum of Understanding.








2. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this Agreement will be separately negotiated and agreed between the faculties, or institutes, which carry out the specific projects.
3. Financial and/or funding considerations shall become the subject of specific discussion and agreement within the framework of a separate implementation agreement. No financial commitment whatsoever, on the part of either signatory to this general document, is intended or implied.
4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support at the institutions concerned.
5. Should any collaborative research activity under this Agreement result in any potential for intellectual property, both institutions shall seek an equitable and fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise.
6. Each institution shall designate a liaison officer to develop and coordinate the specific activities agreed upon.

AND WHEREAS the Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for a period of TWO (2) years from the date of the last signature and will be renewed automatically for the period of same duration unless it is revoked with the understanding that it may be terminated by the appropriate authorities of either party giving two (2) months' notice to the other party in writing, unless an earlier termination date is mutually agreed upon. The MOU may be amended or extended by mutual written consent of the two parties.
