Foreward

It is a matter of great pride and pleasure for me to welcome all the dignitaries, guests, resource persons, members of management and delegates to NAAC sponsored One Day National Seminar on 'Understanding the Parameters of Standard Operating Procedure for Quality Improvement, Quality Assessment and Effective DVV Process' organized by Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Purushottam Khaparde Health and Education society's Yashoda Girls' Arts and Commerce College, Sneh Nagar, Nagpur on Saturday, August 24, 2019.

As per new Quality Indicator Framework (QIF), the assessment process has been divided into two major parts - Quantitative and Qualitative parameters. The Quantitative metrics covers 70% of the total score required for the Assessment of the Higher Educational Institution and hence it is of great importance for achieving higher grades. In addition to it, the 70% assessment of the Quantitative Metrics is done through online process by way of Data Verification and Validation process (DVV) which is done through Third Party. It is to be noted that the institution has to upload all the proofs under these Quantitative Metrics while uploading the Self-Study Report. But it has also been observed that during the DVV process, most of the HEIs have to fulfill the maximum queries raised by the DVV partners and it becomes difficult to provide up-to-date and perfect information to the DVV partners in the given time limit. Therefore, this DVV process has been experienced as a great challenge by the Higher Education Institutions. Owing to difficulties being faced by the HEIs in the form of compliances of DVV partners, NAAC provided guidelines in the form of Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) to make it more convenient and easy. There is need to understand SOP for the Higher Educational Institutions for which the seminar will be beneficial. I am sure that the Principals and the IQAC coordinators and different Stakeholders of the Higher Educational Institutions will get benefited from the Information and ideas disseminated in this National event.

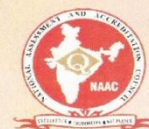

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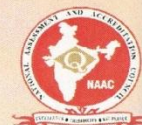
