#### **CONCEPT NOTE**

On the occasion of Aazadi Ka Amrit Mahostav, Dhamma Pravartan Din, Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur Century year and 75 years of friendship with India & Thailand, the Gagan Malik Foundation with its collaboration is organizing an International Conference on the captioned theme.

We, the people of the 21<sup>st</sup> century desire freedom, but what distinguishes human beings is our intelligence. As free human beings, we can use our unique intelligence to try to understand ourselves and our world. The Buddha made it clear that his followers were not to take even what he said at face value, but were to examine and test it as a goldsmith test the quality of gold. But if we are prevented from using our discrimination and creativity, we lose one of the basic characteristics of a human being. Therefore, justice, liberty, equality and fraternity that democracy entails are of immense value and importance.

Peace is a precondition for the realization of human capabilities, their development, the growth of industry, the unshackling of the human spirit of creativity and so forth. The establishment of peace and the realization of human happiness are further based upon the organization of the human society on the values that are commensurate to it. Those are the values of justice, liberty, equality and fraternity which are the founding values of a just society and hence the promotion of justice. Thus, human developments, welfare, happiness, national and global cooperation as well as international peace are very much dependent upon these foundational values. The very idea of justice and peace cannot be expected without the establishment and re-organization of the society on the values of justice, liberty, equality and fraternity. They are fundamental.

The Buddha saw that life's very purpose is happiness. He also saw that, while ignorance binds beings in endless frustration and suffering, wisdom is liberating. Modern democracy is based on the principle that all human beings are essentially equal, and that each of us has an equal right to life, liberty, and happiness. Buddhism foo'recognizes that human beings are entitled to dignity and that all members of the human family have an equal and inalienable right to liberty, not just in terms of political freedom, but also at the fundamental level of freedom from fear and want. Irrespective of whether we are rich or poor, educated or uneducated, belonging to one nation or another, to one religion or another, adhering to this ideology or that, each of us is just a human being like everyone else. Not only do we all desire happiness and seek to avoid suffering, but each of us has an equal right to pursue these goals.

Buddha started his mission of rebuilding the unjust social order on the pillars of love, compassion, maîtree, karuna, character, equality, and brotherhood. Thus the foundation of Buddhism is based on human values, natural justice, and equality. He liberated the shudras from slavery. He also taught and practiced equality between genders and treated women as men's equals, bestowing on them the right to be priests. Both shudras and women were

denied this liberty and equality by the chaturvarna practices before and during the advent of Buddhism. Buddha and Buddhism not only successfully revolted against the institution of caste but also provided an alternate way of life culture which is based on justice, equality, liberty, and universal brotherhood. Commenting on the genesis of injustice and socio-economic inequality in the Hindu social order Dr. Ambedkar observed that men are born equal is a doctrine repugnant to this social order as it does not admit the principle of equality and graded inequality is a fundamental principle. It recognizes slavery as a legal institution. Graded inequality has been in force in economic life too. The first shall never become the last, nor shall the last ever become the first.

This social order of inequality has been reversed in the Buddhist social order. Buddha Dhamma has in it both hope as well as purpose. Its purpose is to remove Avijja means ignorance of the existence of suffering. There is hope in it because it shows the way to put an end to human suffering. Twenty-two vows administered by Dr. Ambedkar at the time of conversion to Buddhism in Nagpur. 1956 subscribe to believe in the principle that all human beings are equal and to endeavor to establish equality and he firmly believed that only Buddhism is Saddhamma. In fact, it was not a conversion but a liberation of Buddhists from Hinduism which was imposed upon them forcibly. The untouchables of today were the Buddhists of the ancient past because as per Dr. Ambedkar, conversion was their return to the original faith to which they belonged in the ancient past. Atta Deepa Bhava of human society is the essence of the whole teaching of Buddha, which means be the light unto yourself. One's action is responsible for everything. In man's action lies his salvation. Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar piloted the constitution of India and therein enshrined the principles of justice, liberty, equality, fraternity, and secularism. The very source of these principles for Dr. Ambedkar was the Dhamma of Buddha. Buddha Dhamma has been interpreted by Dr. Ambedkar in his true perspective as original and not reinterpreted.

#### THE PURPOSE OF THE CONFERENCE

With this background, the Gagan Malik Foundation is organizing an International Conference on the theme of **"Buddhism in Contemporary Times: Relevance of Justice, Liberty, Equality & Fraternity**" to bring together the scholars in contributing to the Relevance of Buddhism in promoting the same.

The purpose is to develop an understanding of the situation concerning Justice, Liberty, Equality & Fraternity in selected countries of the world and India. The scholars will discuss the Buddhist philosophy and practices that have emerged throughout the world and will discuss the social situation that causes and perpetuates subjugation, inequality and conflict in societies and the way to resolve it. The conference further proposes to discuss in general to bring about the experiences of a few Buddhist countries and India in general to bring about social transformation, equal status, equality in well-being and to draw lessons from the National and International experiences for inculcating the values of Buddhism in order to promote social change and harmony in a democratic society.

Theme 1: Emergence of Buddhist Philosophy and Practices throughout the world and India.

The theme will focus on the various ways in which Buddhist philosophy and practices have emerged both in India and outside and the form it has taken to address specific societies.

Theme 2: Buddhist perspectives on Justice, Liberty, Equality & Fraternity- Country Papers

The theme will discuss country-specific Buddhist perspectives engaged in theorizing freedom, equality & fraternity. The focus will be more on the context of the specific societies engaged in the practice of Buddhism in the establishment of peace and happiness.

Theme 3: Buddhism and socio-political and cultural transformation- Experiences of select countries in Asia and India.

The session will bring scholars from select countries in Asia and India which have experienced a positive and transformative impact of Buddhist teachings and practices, in their societies. The theme will focus upon historical, social, political, and culturally specific contexts in which Buddhist ideas and movements have played an important role in social stability and peace.
