# IQAC MEETING REPORT DATED 15th of JULY, 2020

As per the IQAC notice dated 06-07-2020 with respect to the first meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell was held on 15<sup>th</sup> of July, 2020 at 12.00 noon at the ground floor space observing the rules of social distancing. At the beginning Dr. K. G. Meshram, IQAC co-ordinator welcomed all the members and secured permission from the Chairperson of the IQAC, Principal Dr. Dhanraj Shete to read the minutes of the last meeting of the Session 2019-2020 held on 05-05-2020. After taking approval to the minutes of the last meeting the agenda of the meeting was opened for discussion one by one. Each point in the agenda was discussed thoroughly and resolutions were passed as under:-

Resolution No. 1:-The Principal asked all the teachers whether they have prepared the teaching plans as per the institutional academic calendar for the coming session. After taking review of the teaching plan from all the teachers, the teachers were asked to get it approved from the IQAC and to implement it keeping in mind the online teaching requirement during the corona pandemic situation.

Resolution No. 2:- The Principal told all the teachers that there is need to develop an online platform for conducting teaching learning and evaluation work online as the possibility of conducting face to face class room teaching during corona pande mic situation is not certain. It was resolved unanimously to apply for Google-Suit to fulfill the requirement. As the institution has already taken website with educational institution domain, it has become easy to get the Google-Suit, the Principal added.

Resolution No. 3:-

The chairperson of the IQAC said that keeping in view the need of online teaching and conducting continuous evaluation system using online method, the formation of whats app groups be given priority. Accordingly the classes were distributed to the teachers to work as admin for the formation of whats app groups. The group administrators were given instructions to work with responsibility and all the teachers were informed to upload or share educational material/ information on the group.

Resolution No. 4:- The other departments in the college except the teaching department were also informed that they should take approval of their annual activity calendar from the IQAC and implement it as per the sanctioned schedule. The Principal also instructed them that they should keep emphasis on using online mode for organizing programs taking into consideration the corona pandemic situation.

Other subjects:-The co-ordinator, Dr. K.G. Meshram asked everyone if there were any additional subjects for discussion in the meeting. As there were no more topics for further discussion, the IQAC co-ordinator, thanking all the members, concluded the meeting.





# IQAC MEETING REPORT OF SECOND IQAC MEETING DATED 21 October,

2020

As per the IQAC notice dated 07-10-2020 with respect to the Second meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell was held on 21 October, 2020 at 12.00 noon in the ground floor space observing the rules of social distancing. At the beginning Dr. K. G. Meshram, IQAC co-ordinator welcomed all the members and took permission from the Chairperson of the IQAC to read the minutes of the last meeting held on 15-07-2020. After taking approval to the minutes of the last meeting the agenda of the meeting was opened for discussion one by one. Each point in the agenda was discussed thoroughly and resolutions were passed as under:-

Resolution No. 1:-All the teaching departments were informed that they should implement E-governance system to their level best in admission process, Collecting fees from the students as well as while conducting college level examination during the corona pandemic situation and also for adopting health safety measures. Accordingly it was unanimously decided that all the academic and administrative works will be possibly done adopting E-governance system.

Resolution No. 2:-As Dr. Rawlekar was given the responsibility of developing online feedback mechanism, he has implemented effective online feedback mechanism on the institutional website. Now he has been given responsibility to prepare analysis of feedback taken from all the stakeholders and submit its report for further action. It was



unanimously decided that the feedback obtained from the different stakeholders will be considered for quality improvement in the institution.

Resolution No. 3:- The chairperson of the IQAC said that as the actual face to face classroom teaching is hampered due to outbreak of corona virus and the complete teaching, learning and evaluation process is going on using online mode, all the teachers should use Continuous evaluation system using the online platforms on the taught portion so as to prepare students for university examination. They were also instructed to maintain records of the measures adopted by the individual teacher with respect to Continuous Evaluation Method. All the teachers assured that they would adopt the continuous evaluation method covering all the portion taught. Some of them said that they would use Google platform for conducting examinations.

Resolution No. 4:- The Chairperson of the IQAC said that there is need to introduce training to the students with respect to soft skills and life skills which will help to develop their all round personality. Accordingly the IQAC co-ordinator was informed that he should organize soft skills and life skills training program for the students. It was also decided that in order to enlarge the scope of the beneficiary students even from outside the institution, the activities should be conducted forming the cluster of colleges. Resolution No. 5:- The teachers to whom the responsibility of MoUs and linkages have been given were informed that they should conduct one or two activities under their MoU. It was also decided to form more linkages and MoUs and to conduct faculty exchange, students exchange programs by using online platform. The teachers who are the incharge of specific MoU were given that responsibility.

Resolution No. 6:- The Principal took the review from all the faculty members regarding completion of their courses. He also informed the teachers to organize Virtual Classes and engage outside expert faculty members so that it would give revision to the students on the syllabus and it will be a great help to the students in the university examination. It was unanimously resolved that all the subject teachers will conduct virtual classes in their subjects.

Resolution No. 7:- The Chairperson also said that he has talked to the Director of the Lifelong Learning and Extension Department of the RTM Nagpur University and enquired regarding getting approval for online short term certificate courses to the colleges. Accordingly discussion went on and it was unanimously decided that the proposal should be prepared for total six short term certificate courses and the co-



ordinators of the course were given complete responsibility from beginning to the end. The respective departments were instructed to implement the courses for the benefit of the students and do all the required procedure and submit its report in July 2021.

Resolution No. 8:- The Principal said that the institution should organize some awareness programs so as to make the students aware of the safety measures to protect from corona virus, accordingly the Dr. Lalita Punayya, head, department of Physical education was given the responsibility to organize extension activities preferably in the form of online guidance to the students. She was also instructed to introduce some yoga and pranayam programs for the students as to boost their immunity and keep their families safe during the pandemic period.

As there were no more topics for further discussion, the IQAC co-ordinator, thanking all the members, concluded the meeting.



#### IQAC MEETING REPORT OF THIRD IQAC MEETING DATED 27 January, 2021

As per the IQAC notice dated 15-01-2021 with respect to the Third meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell was held on 27 January, 2021 at 12.00 noon in the Principal's chamber. Atthe beginning Dr. K. G. Meshram, IQAC co-ordinator welcomed all the members and took permission from the Chairperson of the IQAC to read the minutes of the last meeting held on 21-10-2020. After taking approval to the minutes of the last meeting the agenda of the meeting was opened for discussion one by one. Each point in the agenda was discussed thoroughly and resolutions were passed as under:-

Resolution No. 1:- The Principal said that there is need to organize professional development programs for non-teaching staff members as well as the Faculty Development programs for the teaching staff members. Accordingly it was unanimously resolved that in order to organize the national level Professional Development Program for the non-teaching staff members, the activity should be organized in collaboration of some colleges. Similarly taking into consideration the need of lacuna of fluency of English language speaking skills among the teachers, the faculty development program be organized in collaboration of a cluster of five colleges so that the faculty will get the opportunity to become competent in English communication. The IQAC co-ordinator assured the Principal that he would organized both the programs as quality initiatives shortly.

Resolution No. 2:- Principal informed Dr. Kapshikar that even during the pandemic period the activities of Competitive examination Guidance centre should go on and he



should conduct them regularly by using online platform. He also said that the experts from outside should be given opportunity for guidance so as to prepare students for the competitive examination and to maintain in them the competitive spirit,

Resolution No. 3:- During the corona pandemic situation as the classroom attendance of the students have been hampered and the activities like cultural competitions and the these activities should be conducted in online mode and Dr. Punayya Madam and Dr. Sonak sir were instructed to take initiatives and organize such training and competitions for the college students.

Resolution No. 4:- Taking into consideration the problems and difficulties of the students with respect to online classes and also the difficulties in the payment of examination fees personally, it was unanimously resolved that the grievances of the students be given priority and the concerned committee was instructed accordingly.

Resolution No. 5:- The Principal said that as the institution has taken initiative to help the poor and economically backward students in the form of Students Welfare Schemes, it was also decided to enlarge the scope of the activities. Therefore, the students' welfare committee was instructed to give scholarship from the students welfare fund to the poor students and also distribute books to them. It was also decided that the poor students be given the masks and sanitizers from the NSS unit in order to protect them from the corona virus.

Resolution No. 6:- It was unanimously decided that after the declaration of the result of Summer Exam 2020 of RTM Nagpur University and after the admission process for PG, the details with respect to the college result and the data related to the progression of the students of the institution to higher education should be added and the AQAR 2019-20 be uploaded on NAAC portal.

As there were no more topics for further discussion, the IQAC co-ordinator, thanking all the members, concluded the meeting with due permission from the chairperson.

# IQAC MEETING REPORT OF FOURTH IQAC MEETING DATED 30 of June, 2021

As per the IQAC notice dated 26-06-2021 with respect to the Fourth meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell was held on 30 of June, 2021 at 12.00 noon on online mode on zoom app. At the beginning Dr. K. G. Meshram, IQAC co-ordinator welcomedall the members and took permission from the Chairperson of the IQAC to read the minutes of the last meeting held on 27-01-2021. After taking approval to the minutes of the last meeting the agenda of the meeting was opened for discussion one by one. Each point in the agenda was discussed thoroughly and resolutions were passed as under:-

Resolution No. 1:- The Principal informed all the faculty members that as there is no chances of commencing the actual teaching in the classrooms, there is need to continue the teaching only with the help of virtual platform. Therefore all the teachers have been instructed to upload the videos and audios they have prepared based on their syllabus on the institutional website before the month of August 2021. At least three videos were made compulsory to upload on the website under the respective departments of the teachers. All the teaches gave their consent.

Resolution No. 2:- The Principal asked all the teachers to prepare the academic calendar of their respective departments as the University has circulated its academic calendar and the session 2021-2022 is going to commence from 2nd of August 2021, hence all the teachers were instructed to prepare their teaching plans and also the plan of activities with respect to the department like NSS, Sports and Environmental education department.
