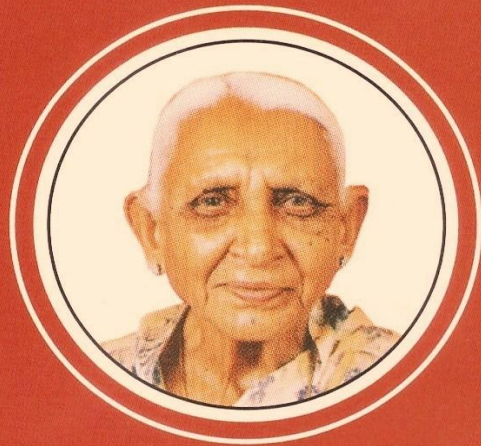

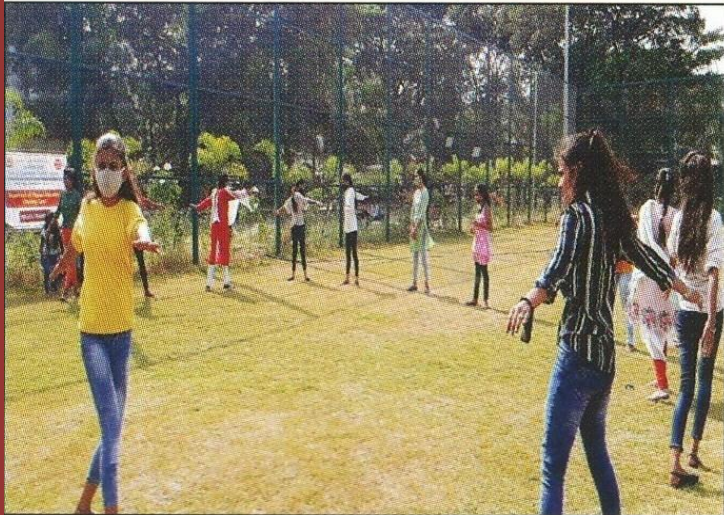

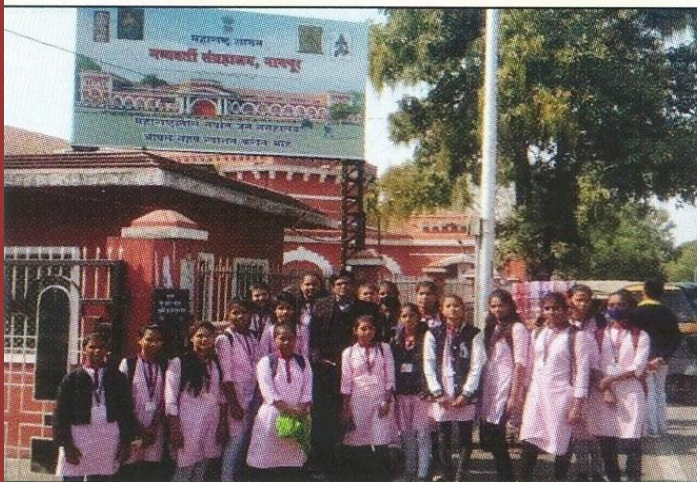


GAMES AND SPORTS:

The College has computer lab for students in which 40 computers are available. The students are provided basic knowledge of computer operation. The computer lab is always available for students with Internet Facility.

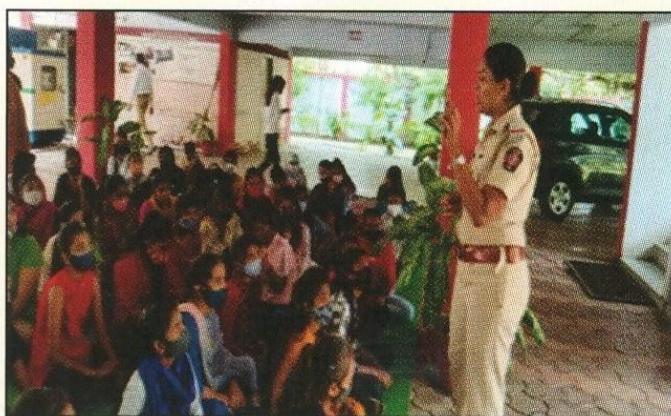


English Language Laboratory :

- ★ The right to grant, refuse or cancel admission is reserved with the Principal.

■ **Rules for Cancellation of Admission:-**

- ★ In case the student is going to cancel the admission within 15 days, 15% amount of the total fees will be retained by the college.
- ★ In case the students turn up for the cancellation of his admission after 15 days, she has to pay full tuition fees.
- ★ In case the students wish to leave the college in the middle of the session, Transfer Certificate will not be issued to her unless and until she pays the entire dues of admission fees or tuition fees.
- ★ Students of B.A. & B.Com in Semester - I will have to fill the enrolment form of RTMNU.

■ **Rules for Students :**

- ★ 75% Attendance in Class is compulsory without which the students will not be allowed to appear in Examination and also for scholarships.
- ★ Students opting practical subjects should attend the practical classes.
- ★ Assignments/Projects as per the rule should be completed in given time.
- ★ Students should fill their examination form for the University Examination in given time limit, they should read the notices of the college regularly, the college will not be responsible for the loss of the students who do not fill the examination forms.
- ★ Attendance to the Unit Tests/ Terminal Tests/ Physical/ Medical Test is compulsory.
- ★ For B. A. & B. Com. Students of Semester III & IV Environment subject will be compulsory and they should submit their projects as well as appear in examination. They will not be given degree if they fail for the same.

- ★ Students can directly contact any time to the Principal if she has any problem or issue with respect to college Classes, cleanliness, complaints with the official works or any kind of problem they are facing.
- ★ Students should not disturb others and maintain honesty, good will and trust in the college.
- ★ Students should not damage the property of the college or they should not make any discrimination with the fellow students.
- ★ They should not engage in ragging/bullying/ assault or in other unfair activities. Such students will be punished.

For any other matter related to the students, final decision will be taken by the Principal.

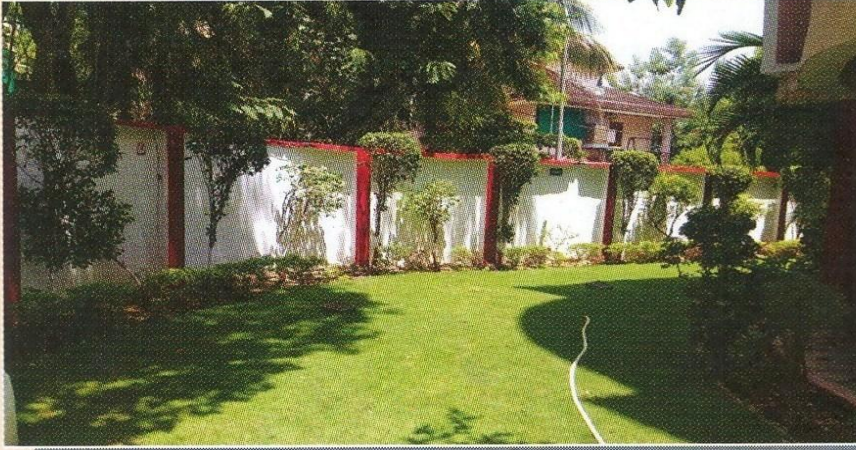

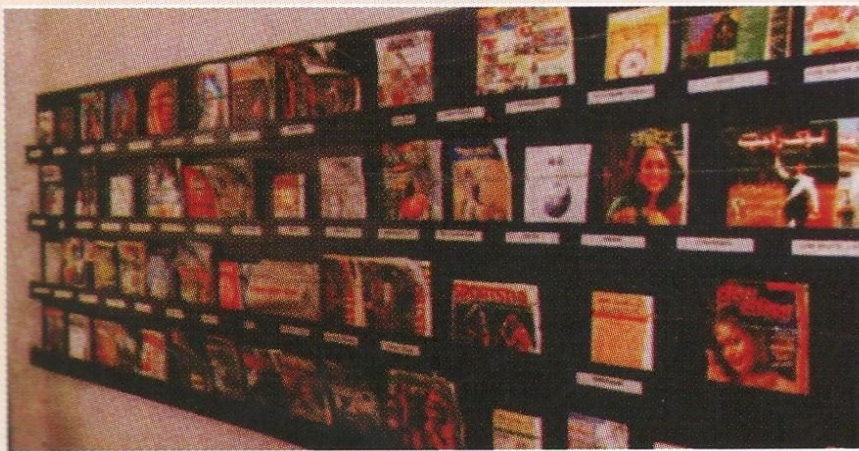
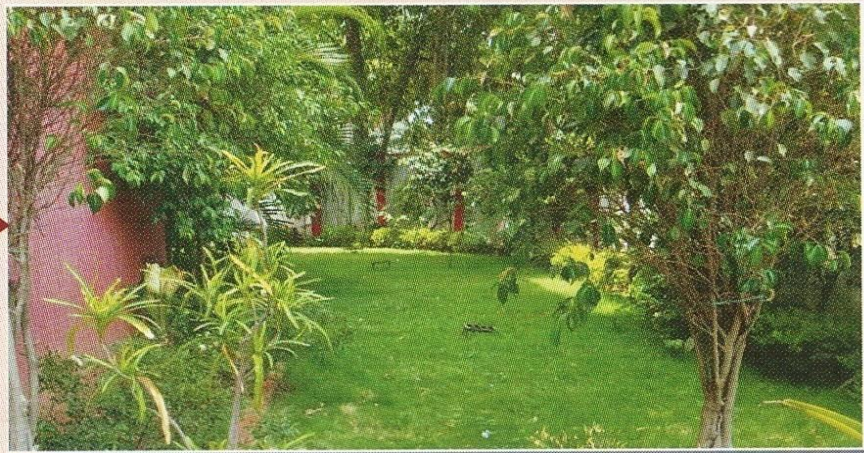
