

Curricular, Co-curricular Activities:

Home-Economics Practical Lab:

Home-Economics is the practical subject. There is a well-equipped practical laboratory for girls in the college for the purpose of practical. Different skill based courses are conducted in addition to the contents in the syllabus by the Department of Home-Economics.

The College has computer lab for students in which 40 computers are available. The students are provided basic knowledge of computer operation. The computer lab is always available for students with Internet Facility.

The College has well-equipped English Language Laboratory. The training of English language communication is provided to the students. The Short-term certificate courses in English Communication are also conducted.

The College has Women's Study Centre which organizes programs and activities for the empowerment of Girls of the College to fulfill the Vision and Mission of the College and also to make girls prominent and responsible women for the positive development of the society and the nation at large.

Unnati Alumni Association:

Unnati Alumni Association fosters the relationship of the college with its old students. Prominent members of the association are invited as guest or as resource person to share their expertise with the current students. The college organizes one or two meetings of the association.





Parent Teacher Association:

In each Session Two Meetings of Parent-Teacher Association is conducted. The parent are given opportunity to talk about their views with respect to the progress of their wards. The College organizes regular educational tours as well as different visits to banks and industries to provide practical experiences to the students. Different departments of the college also organize visit like visit to Vidhan Bhavan, Visit to Mahatma Gandhi Hindi Vishwvidylaya, Wardha, etc.

In order to develop leadership qualities among the girls the best practice on Presentation Skill is conducted every Saturday. The students are given opportunity to make presentation on the topic of their interest so that they can gain stage daring and habit of healthy interaction that would be helpful to them in building their career.

Yashoda Welfare Fund is just to help the poor girls in the college. It is distributed to the students in different forms only to the poor girls such as Scholarship from the Institution, Books for the Poor Girls, Bus Pass for the Poor Girls, etc. There is a committee to take responsibility of distribution of fund.

The institution regularly organizes cultural activities to provide girls opportunities to show their skills and talents. Even the best performers are encouraged to participate in inter-collegiate and University level competitions. The College girls have brought so many laurels to the college.

Admission Rules for BA and B Com

■ The required documents are as under:-

- ★ Original Transfer Certificate or Leaving Certificate.
- ★ Original Mark Sheet of the previous Examination along with Two Xeroxcopies.
- ★ Two passport Size photograph.
- * Aadhar Card or any other ID Proof.
- ★ Caste Certificate, Income Certificate
- ★ Original Migration Certificate for the student of other state Board or University.
- ★ "Eligibility Certificate" from Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University for the students of other State Board or the University.
- ★ Total fees will have to be paid at the time of admission.
- ★ The right to grant, refuse or cancel admission is reserved with the Principal.

■ Rules for Cancellation of Admission:-

- ★ In case the student is going to cancel the admission within 15 days, 15% amount of the total fees will be retained by the college.
- ★ In case the students turn up for the cancellation of his admission after 15 days, she has to pay full tuition fees.
- ★ In case the students wish to leave the college in the middle of the session, Transfer Certificate will not be issued to her unless and until she pays the entire dues of admission fees or tuition fees.
- ★ Students of B.A. & B.Com in Semester I will have to fill the enrolment form of RTMNU.

■ Rules for Students:

- ★ 75% Attendance in Class is compulsory without which the students will not be allowed to appear in Examination and also for scholarships.
- ★ Students opting practical subjects should attend the practical classes.
- ★ Assignments/Projects as per the rule should be completed in given time.
- ★ Students should fill their examination form for the University Examination in given time limit, they should read the notices of the college regularly, the college will not be responsible for the loss of the students who do not fill the examination forms.


